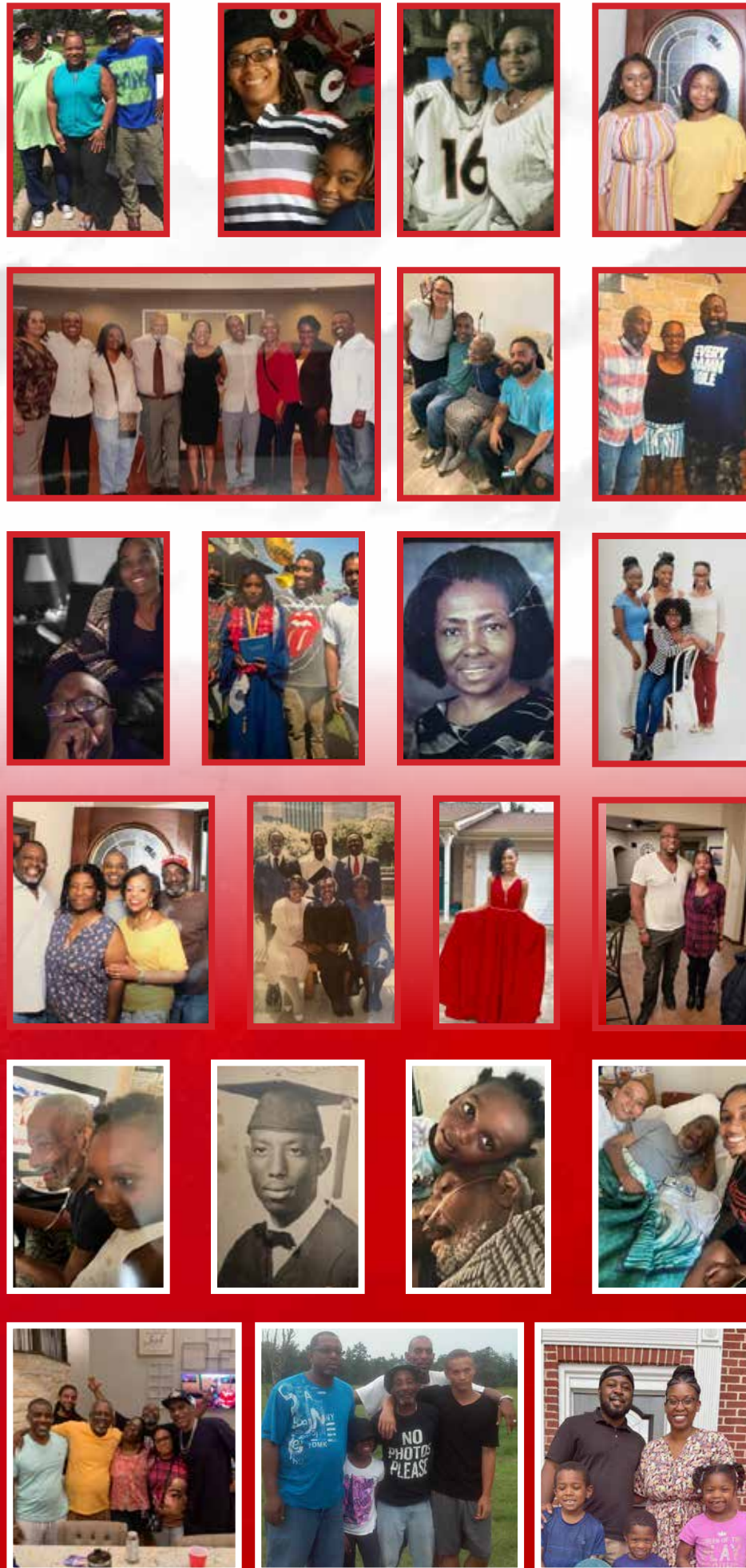
# Obituary
