Mr. Earl Jerome Rhodes was born on November 10th, 1956, to the late Earl Rhodes and Armie Jean Rhodes.

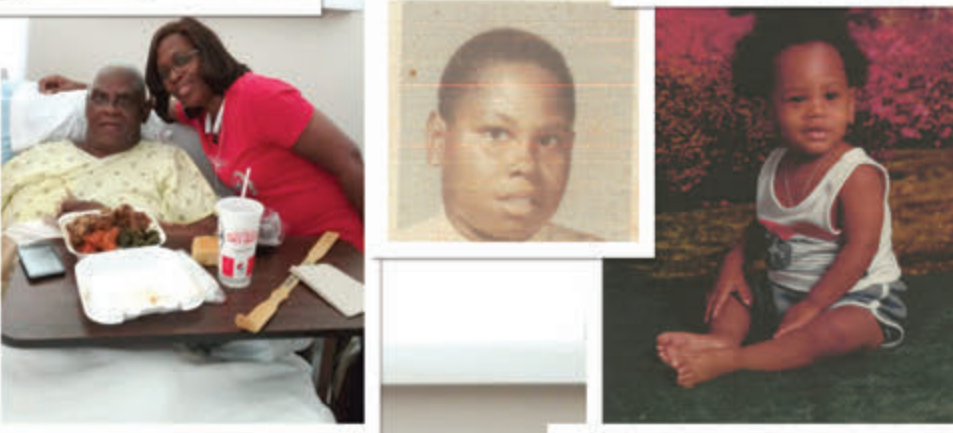
He obeyed Christ in 1974 at South Union Church of Christ under the direction of Bro. Edgar Scott.
