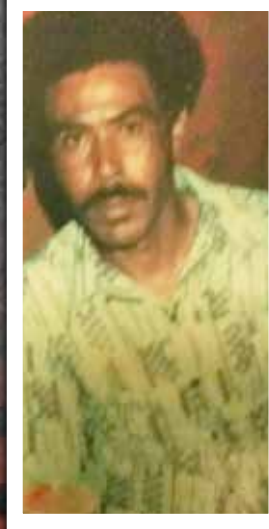


# JOHN'S LIFE
