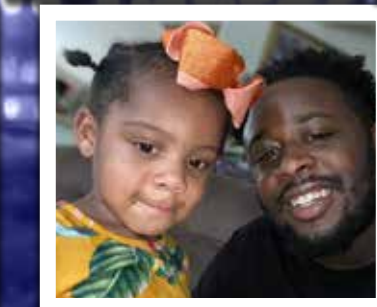
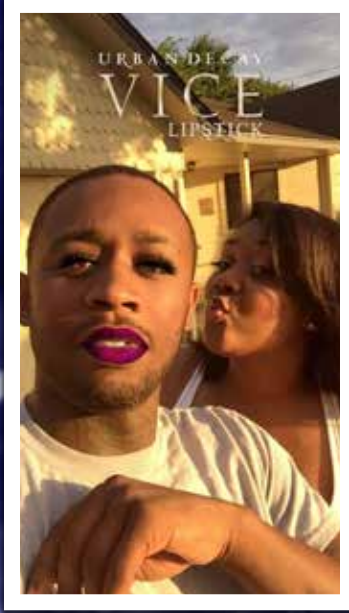
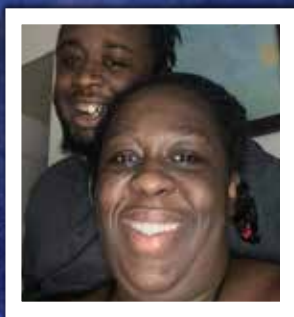
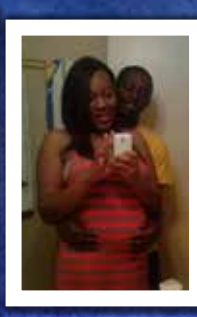
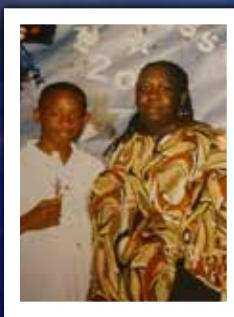
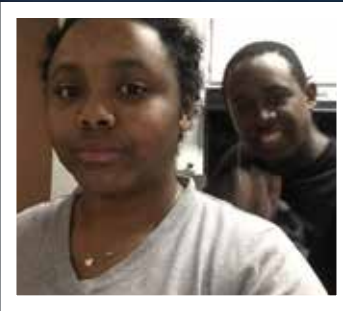
Somewhere in my dreams tonight

"While there's a heart in me, you'll be a part of me,"

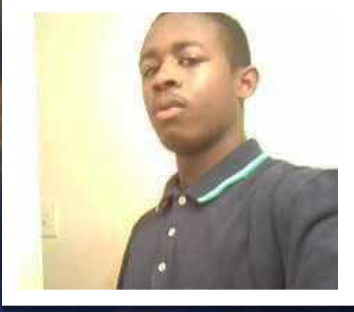
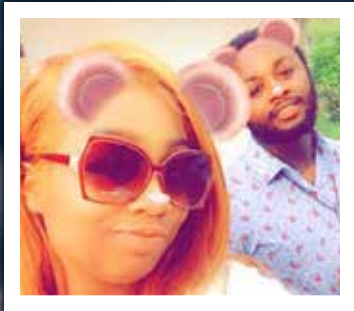
