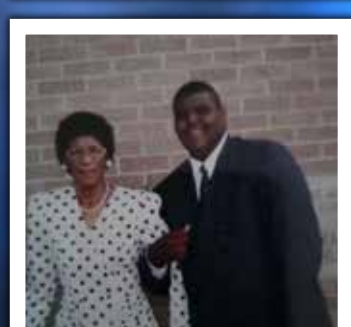
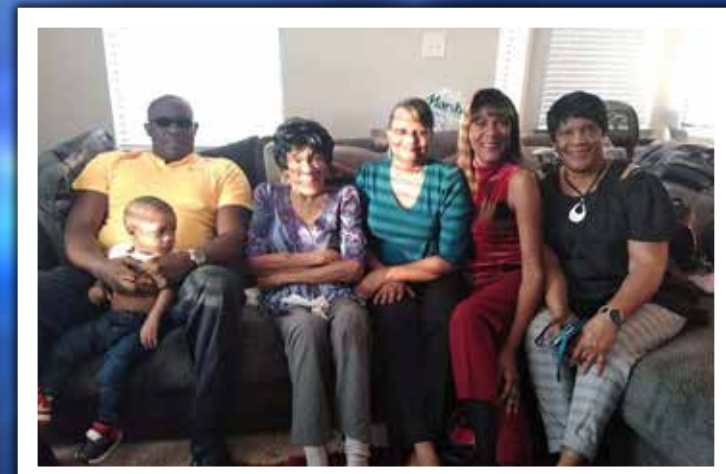
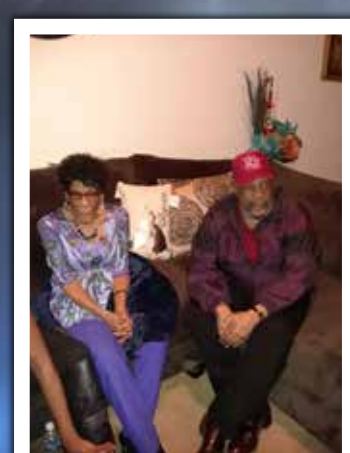
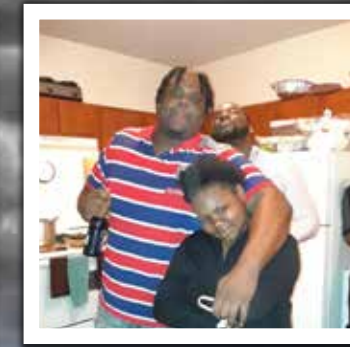
Obituary
