Obituary

Earnest Vinita Hicks, age 67, passed away on Monday, January 31, 2022, at Methodist Hospital in Houston, TX after a month-long battle with Covid-19.

She was a woman of conviction and was not shy about sharing her thoughts and beliefs with anyone she conversed with.
