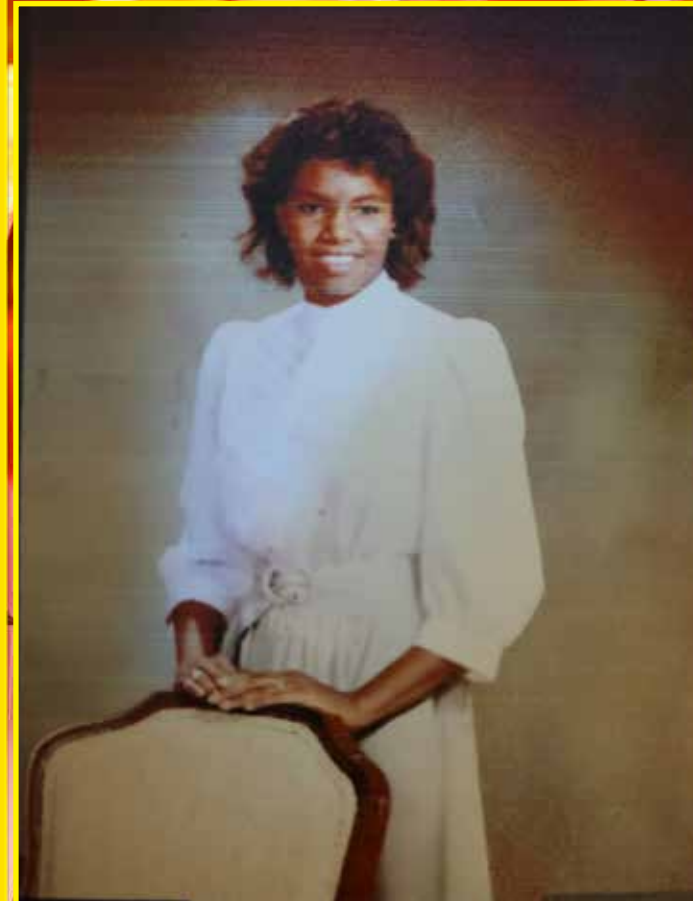

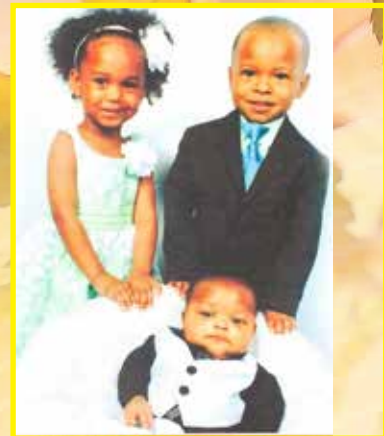
Charol Story
