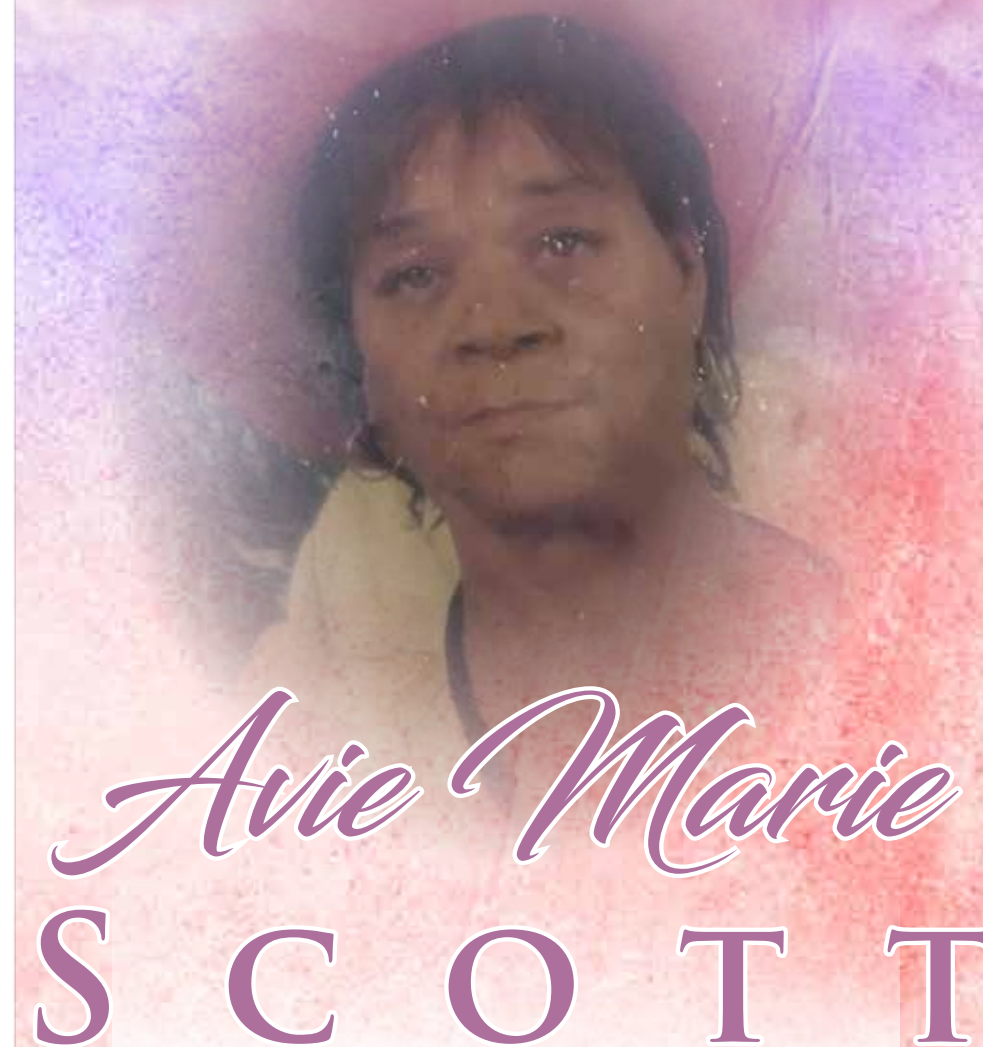

Peaches received her education at Booker T. Washington. She loved playing the piano since she was a little girl which led her to play for several churches by serving the lord.

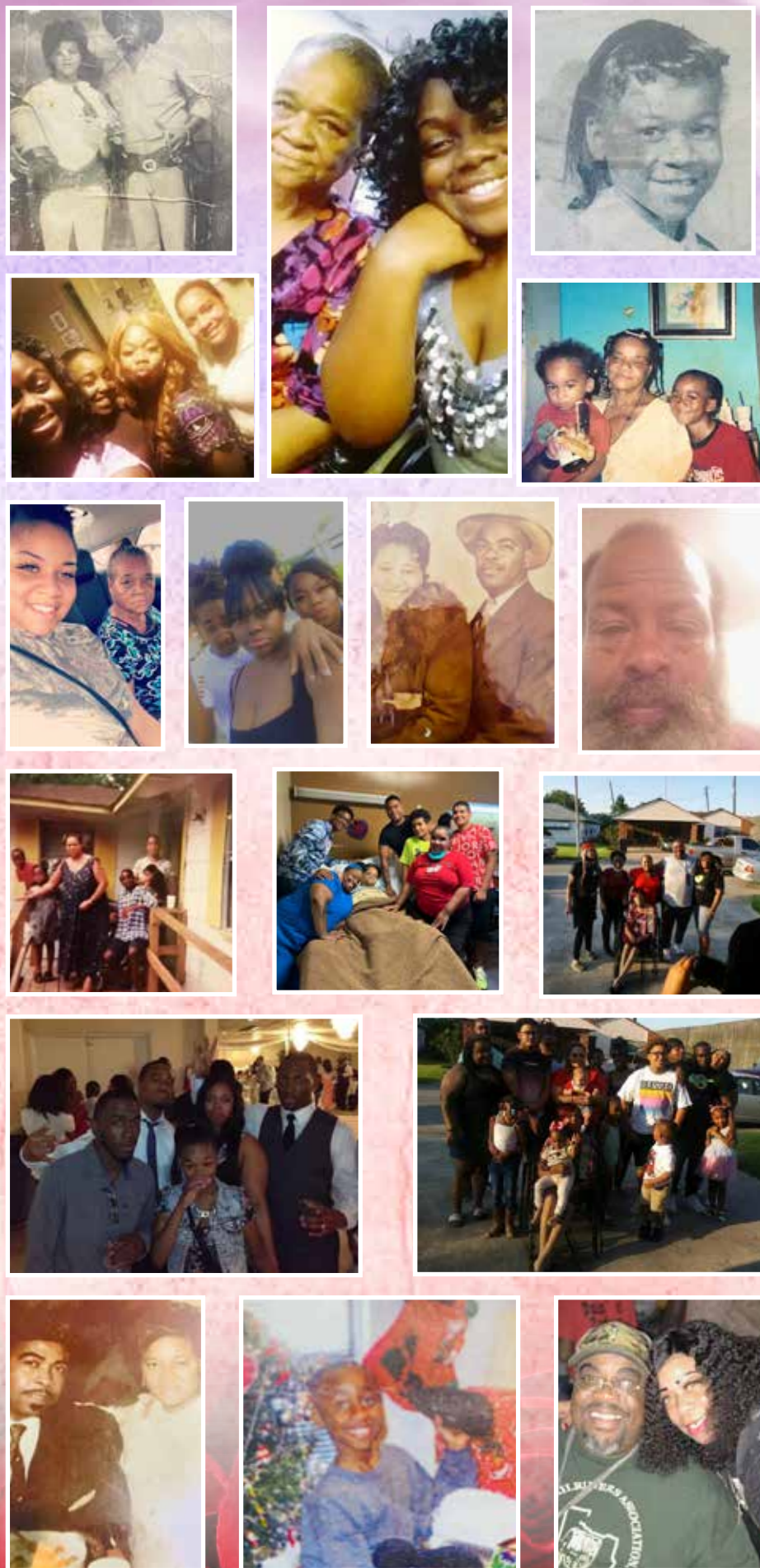
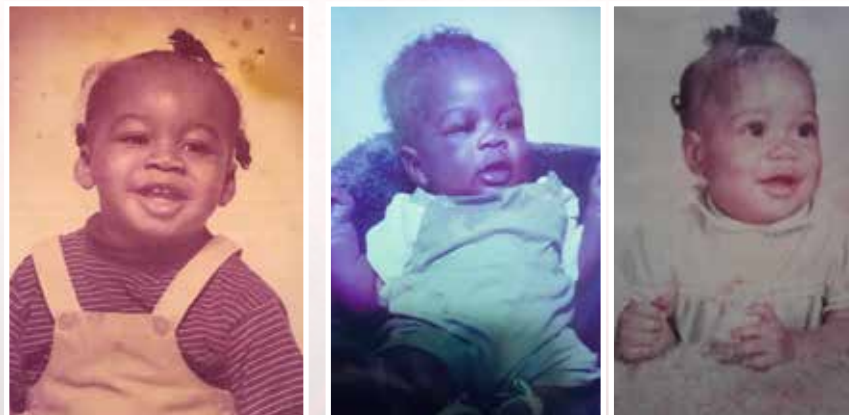
