He was born in Nacogdoches, Texas on December 2, 1974 and was the beloved son to Bernadine (Dean) Durden.

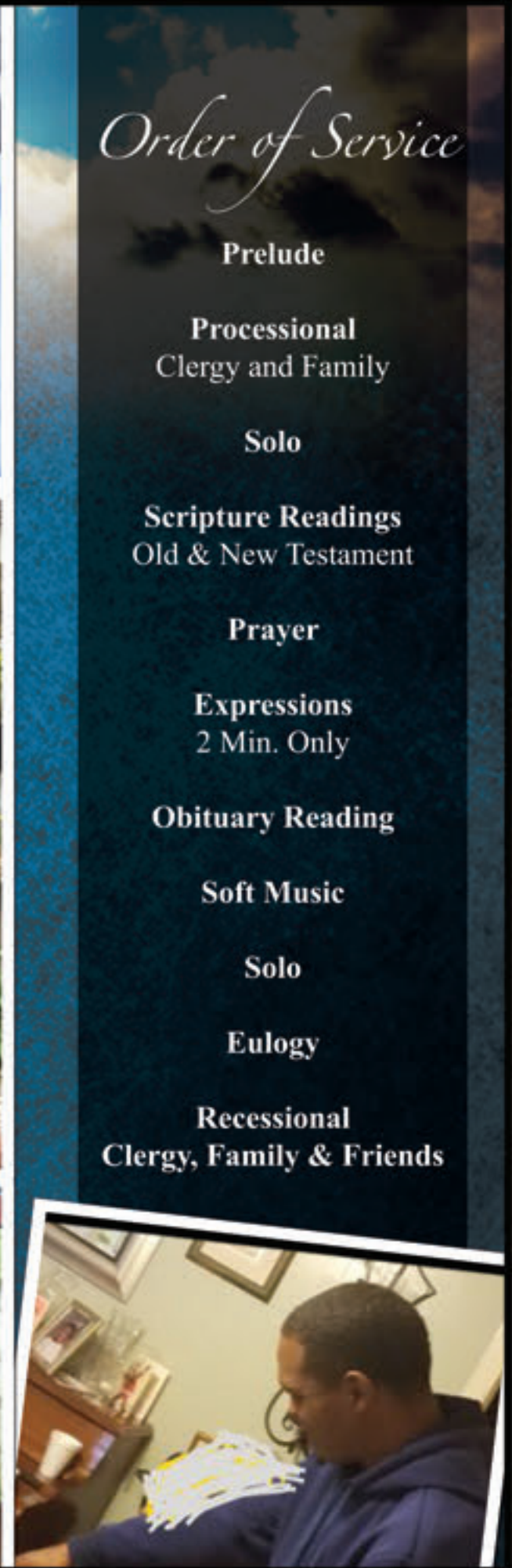
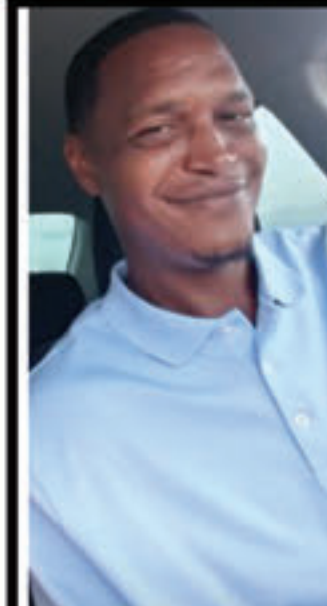
