I now live forever with Jesus in my new home in the sky.

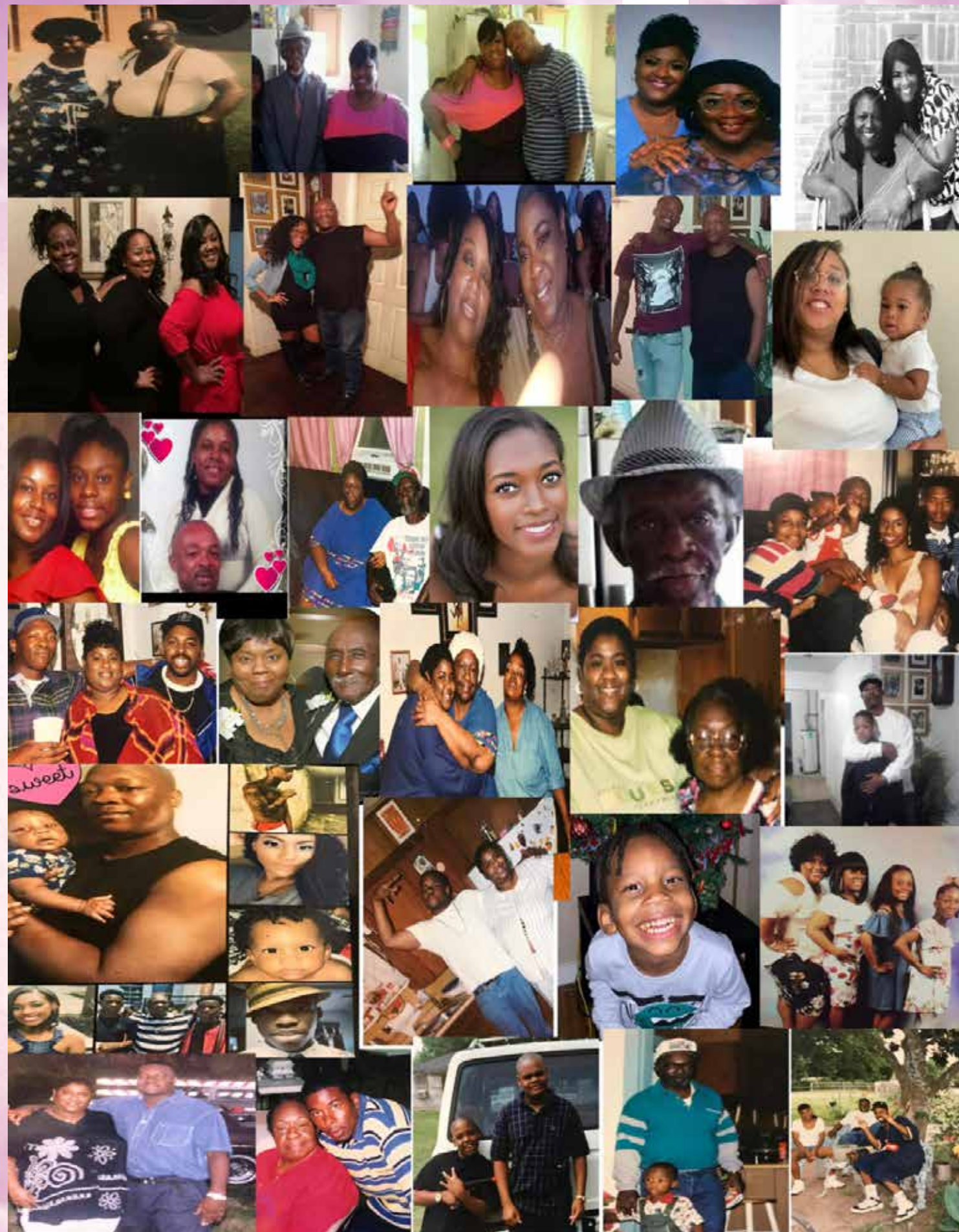
I have no burdens or heartaches And from tears I am now free.
