# Obituary

Oscar James Johnson was God's gift to the late Mrs. Lula and Mr. Thurman Johnson on July 30, 1938, in Washington on the Brazos, Texas. He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Thurman Lee Martel; and four brothers, Lee Thomas Jones, Leroy Gardner, Premo Johnson and Charles Johnson.

On October 30, 1954, Oscar married Georgetta Felder and they had a son, Howard James Johnson who currently lives in Houston. On February 18, 1977, he married Daffie L. Jones and they enjoyed 45 years of marriage.
