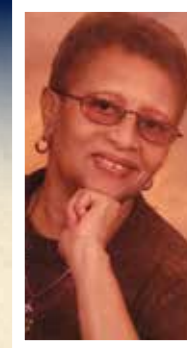
Willie Ann had 2 children Gloria Ann Gauither Washington and John Patrick Guaither
